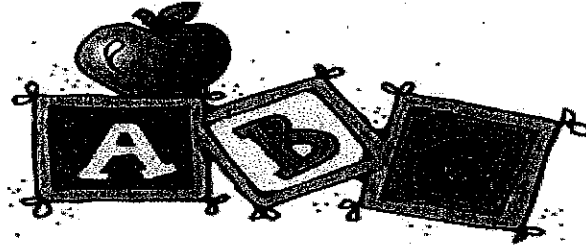


Infant Supply List

- Diapers
 - Wipes
 - Diaper ointment

- Extra Clothes (2 sets)
 - Bibs
 - Blanket and fitted sheet for crib
 - Prepared formula/breast milk in bottles ready to feed. Refrigerator can hold up to 2 packages of frozen breast milk. (No Cereal In Bottles)
 - Jar food (Closed to be stored in cabinet), spoon, and bowl, or food prepared from home.
 - Diaper bag (large enough to store empty bottles and clothes that may be sent home)
